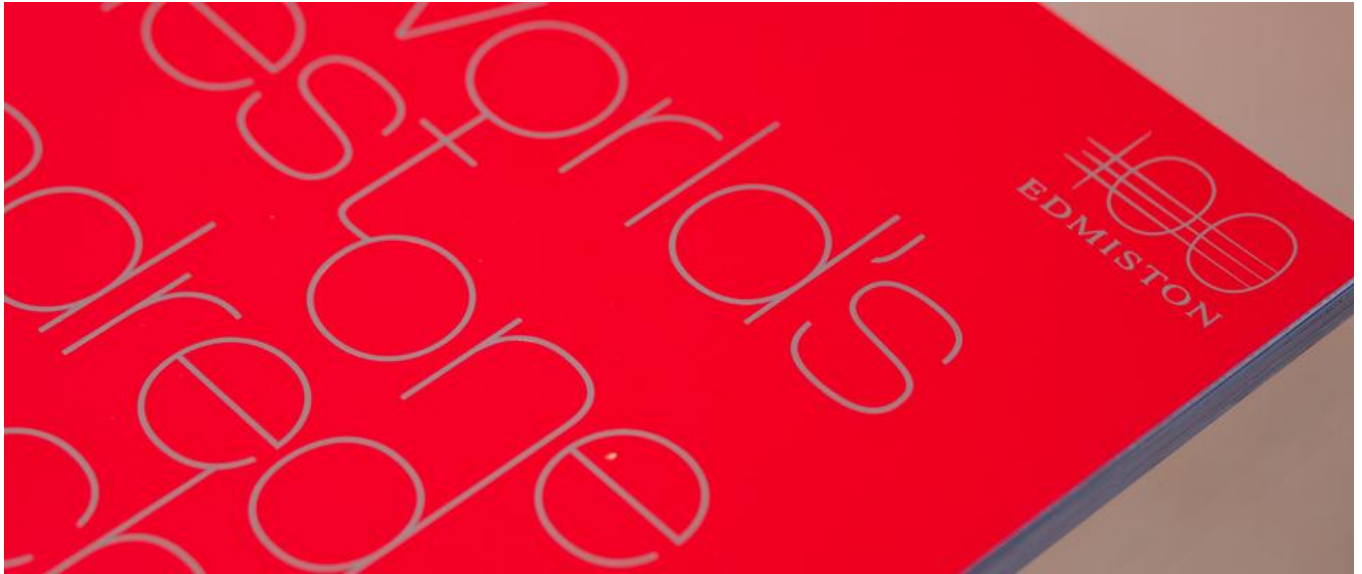

Pegaso – the yacht with the ultimate accessory: a five-person submarine with state-of-the-art imaging and communication links with the mother ship. Pegaso was built for serious sub-sea adventures. Also includes an onboard beach club and spa,

cinema, outdoor gym and trampoline. Sleeps 12 people from €525,000 per week. Perfect for the Pacific.

Lady Britt – Indoor and outdoor cinemas, a wellness spa with qualified Elemis beautician, Finnish sauna, and the Michelin-starred onboard chef, complete with his 40-flavour ice-cream dream fridge) make this a compelling yacht for anyone chartering. Spends summer in the Mediterranean and winter in the Caribbean. Sleeps 12 people from €445,000 per week.

Snowbird – a smaller, 39-metre yacht with the feel of something much larger. Snowbird is a great yacht for socializing as it has several areas for entertaining, including the sun deck with large whirlpool bathtub and BBQ grill. Perfect for a Mediterranean getaway. Sleeps 10 people from €165,000 per week.
