Activities will include fun excursions, theme days such as Jungle Safari and Pirates & Princesses, plus there are naptimes for younger children in specially built sleep rooms. Separate areas will also be available for the Pioneers and Voyagers where they can meet new friends and participate in some great activities including beach cricket, pool Olympics, snorkelling safaris and master chef sessions.
