HAPUKU LODGE AND TREEHOUSES, KAIKOURA -

A HEAD FOR HEIGHTS

The name Kaikoura translates in Maori to 'meal of crayfish' and no visit to this traditional coastal township in the South Island is complete without tasting the world-famous seafood. It's one of the best global locations for wildlife lovers with the giant sperm whale, migrating whales and dolphins all converging in the surrounding ocean and little blue penguin colonies on the beaches. For the best views in Kaikoura, you need to head high, and the five Treehouses at Hapuku Lodge set 10 metres above the ground in the canopy of a native Manuka grove, each deliver with spectacular views of Kaikoura's dramatic mountains and the Pacific coastline. Designed to blend into the environment, their exteriors are clad in native woods and copper shingles with large windows offering a sense that the tree canopy reaches right into the bedroom. The elevated position provides the perfect location for stargazing for the Southern Cross under the crystal clear night skies.

OTAHUNA LODGE, CANTERBURY - VICTORIANA KIWI STYLE

Built in 1895 for Sir Heaton Rhodes, a high-profile pioneer of Canterbury, and his wife Jessie, "Otahuna" is considered one of

the best examples of Queen Anne architecture in Australasia and is now protected by the New Zealand Historic Places Trust. Set between the rocky outcrops of the Banks Peninsula, providing commanding views of the gardens and across the plains to the Southern Alps, Otahuna comprises of just seven classic suites, including two master suites – one complete with a 14 metre private verandah overlooking the Canterbury plains. From rambling woodlands to manicured lawns, the lodge is a haven for nature lovers with one of New Zealand's best displays of daffodils filling the lawns in a blanket of yellow. A grand dining room is the setting for five-course degustation menus, whilst the old game house has been converted into a wine cellar. Or for private dining with a twist, head to the drawing room turret.

Waiheke Island, just 40 minutes by boat from downtown Auckland, is at the forefront of the trend for ultra-small boutique accommodation, with the three-room The Oyster Inn, which opened last year, and the seven room The Boatshed, leading the way. Founded by designer Jonathan Rutherfurd Best and former fashion PR for Louis Vuitton and Topshop Andrew Glenn, The Oyster Inn features just three rooms, with a seafood restaurant, bar, private room, beach shop and take-away all rolled into one. Equipped with a vintage VW taxicab bus on hand for excursions and to collect the guests from the ferry terminal, other unique features include oysters and Champagne given to guests upon arrival, limited-edition yellow-and-white

Havaianas and a Tom Binns jewellery store. At The Boatshed, the Kiwi Beach House tradition is given a twist, with a collection of five suites and two bungalows staying true to the essence of the Kiwi 'Bach'. Owners David Scott, designer, and Jonathan Scott, manager, have a well-respected reputation for creativity and have introduced Art and Architecture Trail packages to take in some of the best galleries, sculpture and design of the unique island.
